Thank You Card from Leung Family

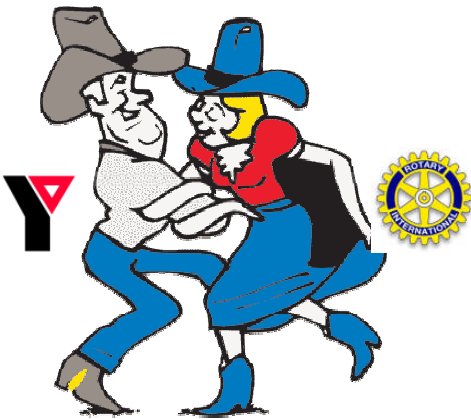
FSR received a thank you card from the Leung family for donating the funds needed to cover the cost of transportation of their son from the Troy High School Football game where he was injured.
