Fullerton Sunrise will be celebrating our 25th anniversary on March 28th at the Elks Lodge. The cost of attendance will be \$50 / person.

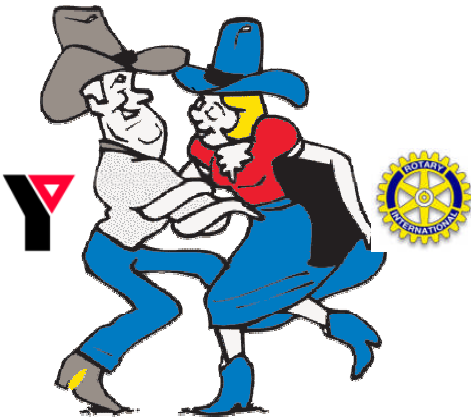
Haiti – Shelter Box Delivery

We are proud to announce that our Shelter Box (1 of 700) has been delivered to the victims of the Haitian Earthquake.

Not only that, but the Shelter Box organization is one of the few organizations that were able to quickly organize and deliver relief supplies to the disaster victims in Haiti.

Shelterboxes are usually packed with one (sometimes two) ten-person tent(s). Other items can include insulated sleeping mats and thermal blankets, water purification tablets, water purification kits, water containers/carriers, a trenching shovel, a multi-fueled cook stove, eating utensils and plates, a children's' activity kit and other essential items.

Shelter Box is also in a recruitment drive. They are looking for individuals in good physical condition and able to participate in a 2 week deployment with little warning.
