Kyle is an Anaheim native and a graduate of Troy High School. He attended American University in Washington D.C. where he majored in International Relations.

Kyle went to the London School of Economics with his Ambassadorial Scholarship and was hosted by the Edmonton Rotary Club of North London.

While there, he championed the plight of Harvey Perry who was born with meningitis and had both of his legs amputated due to the disease. Unable to get proper prosthetics for his legs in the UK, his parents came to the US for comprehensive treatment. But with inadequate insurance to pay for the prosthetics, all funds to pay for the treatments must be raised by his parents and the Edmonton Rotary Club.

Kyle offered to swim the English Channel as a fundraiser for Harvey. Swimming the English Channel had always been a dream for Kyle. Kyle had to stop swimming for 5 years, due to a shoulder issue, but because of modern medicine and family support he is once again able to do what he loves.

And the same time but on a different scale, he also helped Harvey to do the same by raising \$10,000 for Harvey.

Bill Jindra presented a Letter to be used for soliciting donations from sponsors. The letter has been emailed to all members.

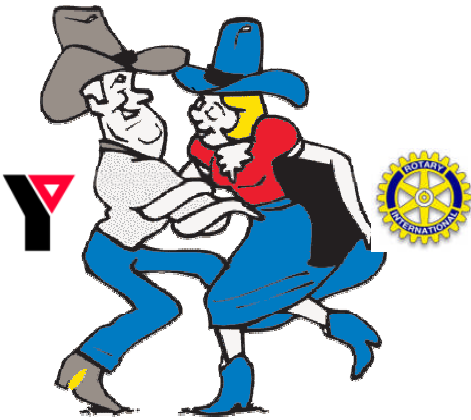
